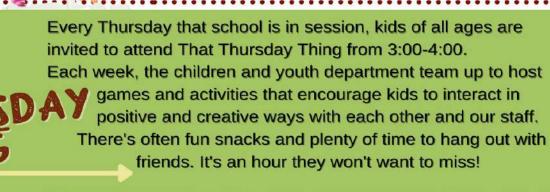

Dinosaurs are invading the library throughout November .... and there's something for everyone to enjoy!

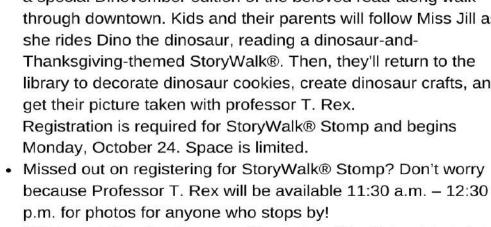
#### For Families and Children:

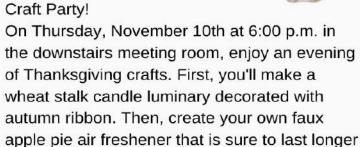
